

USAG-NC LEVEL 5 & 6 TEAM FINALS
RULES & POLICIES
Revised Dec. 2003

At the conclusion of individual competition, the preliminary team results will be calculated based on the top three scores on each event. The top twelve Level 5 teams and top eight Level 6 teams will be announced in alphabetical order, and will be eligible for the Team Championship Session.

Each of the top teams will have 30 minutes from the time of announcement to “accept” their place by paying a \$75.00 Team Finals fee. If a team declines to compete or if a team’s representative is not present to submit the finals entry fee within the 30 minutes, that team will be dropped from the competition and the next team, whose representative is present with their fee, will be accepted. When the schedule is sent out, we will try to give an approximate time of announcement, however **it is the responsibility of the team’s representative to be available immediately following the last regular session.**

Open Stretch for the Team Championship Session will begin a minimum of two hours after the last routine of the last session of that Level.

Team competitive order will be determined by a random draw, to be conducted by the Meet Referee and representatives of each of the top teams as soon as all teams have paid their fee.

Each team may warm-up and compete up to 4 athletes per event, with the top 3 scores counting toward the team total. They can use different athletes on each event or use athletes as all-arounders. Scoring is “new life”. Competition will be Capitol Cup or modified Capitol Cup.

No individual awards will be given. Team awards will be given only.
